### DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

**IF YOU ARE USING *GOOGLE DIRECTIONS* THE ADDRESS WILL BE: 8610 MENTOR RD, KIRTLAND HILLS, OH**

**IF YOU ARE USING A *GPS* YOUR ADDRESS WILL BE 8499 KING MEMORIAL RD, KIRTLAND HILLS, OH, but that is actually a house. The mailbox addresses are 8610 or 8510 (Chincapin Stables) My GPS did not recognize 8610.**

### LOOK FOR THE TRACKING FLAGS!!

FROM THE CLEVELAND AND SOUTH (COLUMBUS) AREA: Take 271 NORTH and merge onto 90 EAST. Take exit 195 for OH-615/Center Street. Turn right onto OH-615 SOUTH/Center Street. Turn left onto Chillicothe Road. Take the 2nd right onto Little Mountain Road. Turn right onto Mentor (aka King Memorial )Road. The address will be on the right. Turn right and follow the tracking flags STRAIGHT ahead to the headquarters, a large yellow house. If you end up at Chincapin Stables (a red barn) you veered to the right ):

FROM THE ERIE, PA AREA: Take 90 West towards Cleveland. Take exit 200 for OH-44 toward Chardon/Painesville/ OH-86 NORTH. Turn left onto OH-44 SOUTH. Turn right onto Girdled Road. Turn left onto Hermitage Road. Take the first right onto Griswold Road. Turn right onto Mentor Rd. The address will be on the left. See above for more detail.

FROM THE PITTSBURGH, PA AREA: Take I-76 WEST to 80 WEST. Take exit 187 and merge onto 480 WEST/OH 14 WEST. Continue on 480 WEST then merge onto 271 NORTH. Follow the directions from CLEVELAND.

FROM THE TOLEDO AREA: Take I-90 EAST, follow the directions from the Cleveland area once they merge onto 90 EAST From the hotels north and east of the test site, follow the Erie directions. For hotels west, follow the Toledo directions. If you are staying south of the test site, take either 71 North or 77 North to 271 North and follow the Cleveland directions.

**THIS IS A RESTRICTED AREA NOT FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND YOU WILL NEED A SPECIAL PASS TO PLACE IN THE WINDSHIELD OF YOUR CAR. I WILL SEND THE PASS WITH MORE SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS IN THE JUDGING PROGRAM.**

ENTRY FEE \$50.00 (TD) or \$110.00 (TDX)

Make checks and money orders payable (in U.S. Funds) to the Buckeye Tracking Club and mail to the Test Secretary. You will be notified by phone or email within 24 hours of the draw. Please include either or both so that I can contact you. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Be sure to use an official AKC form or photocopy both sides. Don't forget to sign it.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES - Entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limits have been reached. Please do not send an entry that requires a signature for acceptance. I am not always at home! Entries will be drawn by the Test Secretary on Thursday April 2, 2015 at 7PM at her home. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, whichever test is entered. Preference is given in the TD test to those dogs who have not yet earned a TD and in the TDX test to those who have not earned a TDX. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on the Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. In the event that either test does not fill a TDX can be exchanged for 2 TD's and vice versa.

ENTRY REFUNDS: Entries who pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with full refund provided the test secretary is notified before the test date and there is an alternate to replace the entry. Call me as soon as you know! Those who decline to be placed on the alternate list shall have their entry fees returned or I can destroy your check. Any dog who makes the draw but cannot run may also have their fees returned only if an alternate competes in their place.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Exhibitors are governed by rules and regulations of the AKC and local ordinances.

DRAWING FOR TRACKS: The Judges will assemble the participants in the test site parking lot for a drawing by lot for the track number of each participant. The times for each draw will be noted in the judging program. The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Judging will begin as soon as possible after the draws.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES: In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if any alternates are present. Alternates will draw for available tracks based on their place on the alternate list. If no alternates are present the judges will designate someone to draw for the absent dog, who may run the track if it arrives before the track is scheduled to be run. If it does not arrive by then it will be marked absent.

PRIZES - Each passing team shall receive a memento of their achievement.

INCIDENTALS: Please join us for lunch following the test. This is a lovely area with open fields, streams, rolling hills and woods. According to AKC regulations, you must keep your dogs on leash at all times and, of course, please pick up your poop!
